CRITICAL RESEARCH AND EDUCATION

The Cabrini Monash Department of Surgery conduct research to predict patient sensitivity to common cancer treatments using a three-dimensional tissue model of a patient's tumour called organoids. Organoids are minitumours that can be grown in a laboratory dish from tissue biopsies. This powerful research tool can be used to test common cancer therapeutics to determine if a patient is likely to respond to treatment. This research has been made possible by generous donors who support this important research.

NEW FACILITIES DESIGNED FOR PURPOSE

The world-class Cabrini Gandel Wing opened in 2019 with significant support from the community. This facility combines the best treatment facilities with the latest technology to ensure that our community receive the very best care. A key outcome of this project is the Day Infusion Centre, where patients receive the most advanced treatment in superior yet comfortable surrounds ensuring the patient's wellbeing.



STATE-OF-THE-ART EQUIPMENT

A new state-of-the-art Da Vinci Robot is available to patients through the gift of a major benefactor. The surgical robot allows doctors to perform complex procedures with increased precision, flexibility and control and provides an alternative to traditional open procedures, allowing for faster recovery and a shorter stay in hospital.

MAJOR PROJECTS

Funded entirely by donors, Cabrini's Family
Cancer Clinic was established in 2003 and is
now the largest private provider of this service
for people with a family history of cancer. The
impact of the Family Cancer Clinic has been
life-changing for many patients and their
families. It has been crucial in helping people
come to decisions about managing their
risk of cancer, with preventative and early
detection strategies.

The Foundation raises money to support Cabrini's growing needs across four key areas:

- · Equipment that constantly needs upgrading;
- Refurbishment of existing 4-bed wards at Malvern into single bed wards with en-suites;
- Research that is critical to transforming healthcare in the future; and
- Investment in building a state-of-the-art Cabrini Cancer Institute by 2025.
